## EAST MAUI ACTIVE CASE ALERT



November 19, 2020

Aloha East Maui Residents,

An East Maui resident tested positive for COVID-19 at yesterday's drive-through testing event in Hāna. This was the only positive case out of the estimated 100 tests administered.

At the time of testing, this individual was asymptomatic—not experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19. This individual is currently stable and isolating at home while being monitored daily by the Department of Health.

This individual was at relatively low risk for infection and has been practicing COVID-19 precautions as advised by public health officials.

All those that came into contact with this individual have already been contacted. Contacts that meet the Department of Health's exposure thresholds will be required to quarantine.

This situation illustrates the stealth of the virus and is a good example of how testing may prevent the onset of spread within the community.

Although circumstances indicate this is a contained case without risk of community spread, households with vulnerable members—such as kūpuna—should amplify safety precautions.

During these challenging times, it is essential that we uphold our values of aloha and kōkua—especially toward those impacted by coronavirus. Together we can navigate this pandemic and keep East Maui safe!

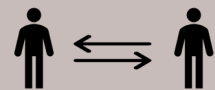
